VAIL PASS TOURS

About our Vail Pass Tour

Get ready for an unforgettable adventure on the Vail Pass ride! This scenic, paved bike path takes you on a winding descent of 2,500 feet-offering jaw-dropping views at every turn.

Starting at 10,600 feet in elevation, this mostly downhill ride is an easy to moderate ride with just a few rolling hills. It's the perfect mix of terrain, making it fun for riders of all ages and abilities.

The ride is approximately 15 miles from the top of Vail Pass to Vail Village (1.5–2 hours door-to-door) and 24 miles to Avon (2.5–3 hours).

** All bikes are upright comfort cruisers. Participants must be able to ride a bike, including the ability to shift gears and operate hand-brakes.

DEPARTURE TIMES

Avon 10 AM | 1 PM

Vail 10 AM | 12 PM | 2 PM

TOUR DETAILS

- ▶ Offered from May 23 through October (weather dependent).
- ▶ The ride from the top of Vail Pass to Vail typically takes 1.5 - 1.75 hours, or 2 - 2.5 hours to Avon, depending on pace and experience.
- ▶ Recommended start time: 10 AM - Colorado mornings can be chilly, and weather conditions can change quickly.
- ▶ Expect temperatures at the top of the pass to be up to 10°F cooler than in Vail.
- ▶ All bikes provided are upright comfort cruisers, and the route stays entirely on paved paths - no off-road riding.

GEARING UP FOR THE BIKE ADVENTURE

- ▶ Wear closed-toe shoes & comfortable clothes for biking.
- ▶ Dress in layers - Vail Pass summit can be 10° cooler than Vail.
- ▶ Wear sunscreen.
- ▶ Bring any medication needed to make the trip safely.
- ▶ Small pack for additional personal items - not necessary but good to have to carry extra layers, additional snacks & water you may want to bring.

RIDER REQUIREMENTS

It's very important that all participants are comfortable and capable of riding a bike. Riders must know how to shift gears and use hand brakes confidently. The tour includes a descent of over 2,500 feet in elevation, so a comfort level with downhill riding is essential. There are also a few short uphill sections that require basic climbing ability. If your group has a range of experience levels, we will divide into smaller groups to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable ride.



VAIL PASS TOURS

What to Wear & What to Bring

TOUR DETAILS

From the top of Vail Pass, the ride to Vail Village typically takes 45 minutes to 1.5 hours, or 1.5–2 hours to Avon, depending on your pace, fitness level, and riding experience.

Temperatures at the top of the pass can be up to 10°F cooler than in Vail Village, so we recommend bringing an extra layer.

All bikes provided are upright comfort cruisers, and the route follows smooth, paved paths the entire way—no off-road riding required.

GEARING UP FOR THE BIKE ADVENTURE

- ▶ Wear closed-toe shoes & comfortable clothes for biking.
- ▶ Dress in layers
- ▶ Wear sunscreen.
- ▶ Bring any medication needed to make the trip safely.
- ▶ Small pack for additional personal items - not necessary but good to have to carry extra layers, additional snacks & water you may want to bring.

At approximately two hours, this tour is an ideal option for those seeking a rewarding outdoor experience that fits easily into the day. Whether you're new to e-bikes or simply looking for a relaxed adventure with stunning scenery, this route offers a memorable ride without the strain.

VAIL E-BIKE GUIDED TOUR

DEPARTURE TIMES

Vail Village - 10:30 AM | 1:30 PM

TOUR DETAILS

- ▶ Offered from May - October (weather dependent).
- ▶ Tour includes a snack at the half-way point.
- ▶ Round-trip time is approximately 2 hours.
- ▶ All bikes provided are class 1 pedal-assist e-bikes.
- ▶ The tour is a great way to experience the natural beauty of the Vail Valley while enjoying a moderate cycling experience.

TERRAIN OVERVIEW

The path is primarily on paved bike path with small sections of road.

Expect a gentle climb as you head east, with an elevation gain of approximately 440 feet over the course of the ride.

GEARING UP FOR THE BIKE ADVENTURE

- ▶ Wear closed-toe shoes & comfortable clothes for biking.
- ▶ Dress in layers - weather in Colorado can change quickly.
- ▶ Wear sunscreen.
- ▶ Bring any medication needed to make the trip safely.
- ▶ Small pack for additional personal items - not necessary but good to have to carry extra layers, additional snacks & water you may want to bring.

RIDER REQUIREMENTS

This easy-to-moderate ride is perfect for riders who are comfortable on a bike and confident with gears and hand brakes.

Minimum height requirement: 4'10"

▶ Departure Times:

Avon: 10 AM | 1 PM (2 - 2 ½ hours round trip)

Vail Pass: 10 AM | 12 PM | 2 PM (1 ½ - 2 hours round trip)

Vail E-Bike: 10:30 AM | 1:30 PM (1 ½ - 2 hours round trip)

- ▶ Snacks and bottled water are included for guided trips.
- ▶ Participants must be able to ride a bike, including the ability to shift gears and operate hand-brakes.
- ▶ Bike trailers and e-bikes are not allowed on Vail Pass.

RIDER REQUIREMENTS

▶ All participants should be comfortable riding their own bike and confident using hand brakes and shifting gears. Riders must be at least 8 years old and a minimum height of 4'1".

▶ **E-Bike Requirement:** Minimum height for e-bike riders is 4'10".

▶ Vail Pass Considerations:

This tour includes a descent of over 2,500 feet, so riders should feel confident on downhill sections. There are also a few short uphill stretches that require basic climbing ability. Ensuring all participants are comfortable and capable on a bike is very important for a safe and enjoyable experience.

- ▶ 24 hour advanced reservations are highly recommend
- ▶ Same-day rentals and tours may be offered based on availability
- ▶ To ensure the proper bike fit, please provide each guest's name, gender, and height at the time of booking
